STOP DOING THIS.

As you consider supporting At The Core and the Bite-2-Go program, we ask you to...

PICTURE THIS:

In Spokane County, 22.3% of children are food insecure (meaning a household-level economic and social condition of limited or uncertain access to adequate food). That is 24,280 total children. Simply put: 1 in 4 Spokane children are unsure of where their next meal will come from. Reality gets a little more disturbing when you picture this: the percentage of kids living at or below the poverty line in the Spokane area is 27.2 %. The most impoverished subgroup in our community is children ages 0-18.

NOW PICTURE THIS:

Your organization, At The Core, and Second Harvest Food Bank partner to provide weekend meals to hungry kids who depend on free breakfast and lunch during the week at their school. Each child receives a "Bite 2 Go", a kit of shelf-stable food, tucked discreetly in their backpack on Friday. Each food kit includes: 2 shelf-stable milks, 2 bowls of cereal, a cup of applesauce and cup of peaches, 2 cans of Chef-Boy-R-Dee pasta: Ravioli and Beefaroni, apple juice, grape juice, a package of cheese and crackers, a package of sunflower seeds, and a package of trail mix. It costs \$144 or \$12 per month to feed one child over the weekends for the entire school year.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

At The Core helps your business adopt a local school for a 3 year period. Our schools coordinator meets with the school administration and staff get an estimate of the number of children who will need this support. Your involvement may simply be as important as funding or jointly funding the program with a church or another business. If you choose to be more involved At The Core is here to

help. We will support you to inspire sponsors, recruit and train volunteers, and network with other organizations to fill the need at your adopted school. We also communicate with Second Harvest, provide creative ways to augment the program in your context, and offer fresh ideas for making your business' Bite-2-Go program uniquely yours!

We make it easy for your business to be as hands-on or off as fits you. If you want to be more hands on options could include:

- Packing food at Second Harvest on a periodic or regular basis
- Periodically adding inspirational messages, additional food or hygiene items
- Being responsible for delivering the packages weekly to the school coordinator
- Reading and or other in-classroom student assistance
- Working with your adopted school to help as needed with projects

Children receiving the food are anonymous to those who sponsor them, and to the rest of the students at school. There is not enough room to pen all the stories of children and families who have been helped in the past and will be helped through caring churches, businesses and individuals like you. Let us know what questions you have and if and how you want to proceed.
